This *Special Day for Special Kids* will celebrate our favorite NYC subway lines. Families are encouraged to dress up in their favorite subway line colors and are invited to participate in train line themed activities. Every guest will have the opportunity to walk through historic turnstiles, sit in the driver's seat of a NYC bus, and explore over twenty different historic train cars on the Museum's platform.
