AWARDS PRESENTATION

SUSAN EHLERMAN

Susan Ehlerman is a social communication specialist with a focus on bridging communication across neurotypes. Over the last 22 years, she has developed the social therapeutic intervention for the NYC Public Schools' Nest Program (NYU), which is the largest strengths-based, inclusion model for autistic students in the US. She has joyfully co-designed the New York Transit Museum's Subway Sleuths program, an award-winning after-school program for autistic train enthusiasts with Lauren Hough Williams. A Speech-Language Pathologist and mindfulness teacher, Susan created The Middleground: a framework which embraces different perspectives to foster transparent and connected communication. It guides her private practice and she relishes in adapting the paradigm to the schools, universities, museums, and communities with whom she collaborates. Susan regularly co-conspires with neurodivergent adults to build therapeutic spaces that honor communication preferences, abilities, challenges, motivations, and advocacy in the pursuit of a more inclusive world.

LAUREN HOUGH WILLIAMS

Lauren Hough Williams is Executive Director of the Program for Inclusion and Neurodiversity Education (PINE) at NYU Steinhardt. Over her 15-year career at NYU, she has built innovative professional development programs that have trained thousands of educators and supported over 50,000 students nationwide. She co-created the New York Transit Museum's Subway Sleuths program, an award-winning after-school program for autistic train enthusiasts—a model for accessible museum programming with Susan Ehlerman. Lauren also co-directed the largest autism inclusion program in the U.S., helping to scale it citywide across New York City public schools, and has partnered with cultural institutions like SUMMIT One Vanderbilt to embed accessibility and inclusion into community experiences. A special education teacher by training and a disability rights champion at heart, she is recognized as a leader who bridges systems—schools, universities, nonprofits, cultural organizations, and companies—to ensure that neurodivergent individuals and communities are seen, centered, supported, and celebrated.

THE HONORABLE KATHY HOCHUL

Kathy Hochul is the 57th Governor of New York–and the only woman to hold the office in State history. The first governor from Upstate New York in more than 100 years, Governor Hochul's tenure has been defined by her efforts to tackle the affordability crisis, introduce comprehensive gun safety reforms, and dramatically increase statewide housing supply. She has emerged as a national voice on abortion rights and mental health, and has positioned New York as a global leader across future–facing industries like high–tech chip manufacturing and Al innovation. A native of Buffalo, Governor Hochul has dedicated her life to public service–and cheering for the Buffalo Bills.
